Dear Parent(s) or Guardian(s) of a Member of the “Class of 2019”,

As the end of the year quickly closes in, it is time to begin preparing for your son’s junior year. In an effort to help your son create the most appropriate schedule, I will be meeting with him to discuss his schedule for next year as well as any other academic issues. This meeting will take place during the school day. Enclosed is a scheduling sheet. Please take the time to complete the form with your son. Feel free to include any questions/notes that you may have regarding his scheduling.

Return the completed form to school no later than **Tuesday, April 11<sup>th</sup>**. Forms may be turned directly to me or to Mrs. Posa. I will begin meeting with students the week of April 23<sup>rd</sup>.

Some important factors to consider when choosing your classes include:

- Is my strength of schedule appropriate? Should it include AP courses? How many?
- There will be summer assignments for certain Honor/AP courses. Students will be expected to have it completed by the first day of school (as is summer reading).
- How is my elective going to help me prepare for college or narrow possible career choices?
- When will I be taking the ACT/SAT? Where am I in the college selection process?

The information you provide on the course selection form does not guarantee placement into a class or a specific teacher. All requests are subject to approval by the academic department and may be determined by teacher recommendations. Please give your class selection serious reflection. Make sure you provide at least one alternative elective. Once your schedule has been generated it may not be possible to change it due to the logistics involved.

Schedules will not be released until all necessary school forms have been received by St. Mary’s Preparatory. Schedules will most likely be mailed out by the end of July. If you do not receive a schedule in the mail by the second week of August, please contact the school office to ensure that all necessary paperwork has been turned in.
